TODAY

We've rolled back the building and now we're rolling it forward. You'll already see the formation of the two upstairs flats and the first fix electrics while downstairs you'll get a feel for the size of the commercial/retail spaces being formed and see the blockwork underway for the new extension and the work on the toilet block. Electrical, Water and Broadband services are currently going in – that's the reason for the big hole at the front.

TOMORROW

In the early part of next year will see the completion of the plastering of the flats and the new sound-proof flooring going in, second fix electrics completed and kitchens and bathrooms being installed.

The current entrance door will drop to the floor and a new ground level entrance will be created allowing access for all through the Queen Elizabeth II Walkway. The commercial retail units will be formed, and the flooring levelled.

We had some delays in changing the front of the property as a result of changing planning and conservation officers but we hope to be underway on this in February, given the lead in time on materials.

FUNDING
